



## Housing Plan Correction 2024– 2025 Award Year

**PURPOSE:** Beginning with the 2024 – 2025 award year, students must submit the Housing Plan Correction form to report a change in their housing plan. The housing plan determines the estimated Cost of Attendance (COA). A student’s estimated COA is the total cost to attend college for one academic year. The COA includes tuition and fees, room and board, books, supplies, transportation, personal expenses, and loan fees. The COA is the baseline to determine a student’s financial aid eligibility, and establishes financial need for grants, and loans. It also sets a limit on the amount of aid a student can receive. Please review the [Schedule of Tuition and Fees](#), and COAs for the 2024/25 year found in the 2024/25 HU General Catalog.

**NOTE:** This change may result in adjusting the Cost of Attendance and/or financial aid awards. The Housing Plan Correction form can be submitted any time throughout the quarter. However, the COA will not be updated until after the end of the quarter.
